Aquatic members are responsible for the delivery of customer service excellence through member satisfaction and safety during recreational swims as well as instruction of both individual and group swimming lessons.

Responsibilities:

- Primary responsibility of Lifeguard shifts and instruction of Lifesaving Society Swim Lessons to a variety of age groups;
- Ability to provide excellent customer service to members and participants by ensuring health, safety regulations and Thomson Lake Regional Park Pool policies and procedures are upheld;
- Operate till while maintaining all relevant and required records;
- Develop lesson plans and administer progressive evaluations;
- Work with staff and volunteer assigned to aquatic area;
- Maintain and upgrade as required current qualifications and certifications;
- Experience in the usage of cleaning supplies for the facility;
- Attend scheduled training events and meetings

Qualifications:

- Standard First Aid & CPR-C
- National Lifeguard Service Certification (Senior) **or** Bronze Cross Certification (Junior)
- Lifesaving Society Swim Instructor Certification
- Current police records check with vulnerable sector search (issued within the past 6 months) is a condition of employment

*If you hold your Bronze Cross Certification and are under the age of 15, a copy of the Young Worker Readiness Certificate Course is required.
